The 17th annual “Diverse-City: Embracing Differences in Your City” art competition is now accepting submissions. The Diverse-City art competition offers students the opportunity to present their independent understanding and awareness of diversity and inclusion within their communities and school. Students will be able to use their creative abilities and talents to express their own insight of diversity and inclusion in the St. Louis region.

Eligibility

All students grades Kindergarten to 12th grade residing in the St. Louis Metropolitan Area. Students will compete in the following categories: K-2nd grade, 3rd-5th grade, 6th-8th grade, 9th-12th grade.

Submission Requirements

Artists’ submissions can include watercolors, oils, pastels, pen and ink, charcoal, photography, two dimensional, sculptures, mixed media, computer-generated and digital pieces (including animation, video and motion work). Two-dimensional artwork will be no longer than 24 inches by 30 inches.

Review Process

A panel of judges will evaluate entries on the basis of theme interpretation, composition and originality. The artist’s names and schools are kept confidential until judging is complete. **Competition winners’ artwork will be featured in a special 3-day exhibition at the Regional Arts Commission.**

Prizes

1st Place: Voucher for one class at COCA (Center of Creative Arts) and \$75 dollar Visa Gift Card

2nd Place: Voucher for one class at Craft Alliance and \$50 dollar Visa Gift Card

3rd Place: Four passes to the Magic House, St. Louis Children’s Museum and \$25 dollar Visa Gift Card
